Beach Buddies: This is a new Cloverbud curriculum offering leaders/educators a series of experiential activities they can do with youth before going to a beach, while they are at a beach and after a beach experience. Activities introduce simple science and conservation concepts to young Cloverbuds as well as build social and developmental skills. Activities utilize their imagination, creativity, curiosity, senses, and more. A teaching kit supports the curriculum and consists of discovery tools, beach animal replicas, storybooks and more.

Exploring Science: Using popular children’s books, science experiments, and creative and recreational activities, you’ll create easy-to-use kits to introduce Cloverbuds to scientific concepts.
