2010 County Impacts and Outcomes

Educational Program Focus:

- **Health, Nutrition and Food Safety in Bay County**
Educational programs targets adults, school age youth, and food service operations on nutrition, diabetes, portion control, sodium, fats/cholesterol, food safety, and overall wellness. ○ Education programs are carried out through classes, displays/health fairs, The News Herald and other media releases, website, and print materials. **Impacts**
 - 9,688 individuals participated in group learning ○ 20% more diabetic participants spaced carbohydrate intake evenly over the past 5-7 days ○ 80% diabetic participants A1C was less than 7.5, 7 or less is the goal for diabetics
 - 77% of youth increased knowledge on nutrition, consuming recommended servings of fruits and vegetables

- **Administration and Leadership in Bay County**
Provide leadership to three county faculty, three program assistants, one support staff, ninety-two Master Gardener volunteers, twenty-nine 4-H volunteers, and eight Home and Community Education Volunteers. **Impacts** ○ 2009 - Relocated from 2,500 sq. ft. office space to 5,000 sq. ft.
 - 2010 - Received 2010 7-passenger van ○ 2010 – Renovations of auditorium, workroom, Master Gardener office
