



4-H Pledge Scavenger Hunt

Supplies needed: Cards with word to the 4-H pledge

Preparation before the activity:

- * Print the words of the pledge on two different colors of paper (green/white), cardstock, or cards. If several youth are playing you may need additional colors of paper. See next page.
- * Prior to their arrival, place the cards around the room or area where you plan to work with the youth.

Activity:

1. Divide the youth into 2 teams. Green and White for the 4-H colors.
2. Have all the youth that have been designated the White group look for all the white cards or papers around the room. Green group looks for the green papers. Remind them that they will need to find a total of 20 cards.
3. Once they have found all the word cards, than they should try to figure out what the secret message is, by arranging the word cards into sentences and arranging them in the correct order. Younger children may need you to give them clues or be told that the words make up the 4-H pledge.
4. The first team that gets the word cards in the order of the pledge and can say the pledge as a team, they are declared as the winners!!!
5. HAVE FUN!!!
