APPEALS COMMITTEE

Basic Function

To receive and act upon any protests arising out of any district level competitive event. This committee is comprised of the Area A Horse Show Advisory Executive Committee. This includes the President, Vice President, Secretary, Agent Liaisons, and State 4-H Advisory Committee Representatives.

As outlined in the Area A Handbook, appeals must be submitted in writing and accompanied by \$50.00 cash immediately following the class or event. If the protest is upheld by the Appeals Committee, the deposit shall be refunded. If the protest is over-ruled, then the deposit shall be forfeited to the Area A Horse 4-H Advisory Committee fund.

Specific Responsibilities

- Be familiar with the State 4-H Events and Activities rules and procedures
- Be objective and fair to all parties involved
- Make sure that you have all of the information before making a ruling
- Above all, the youth's safety (emotionally and physically) is the top priority
