- **As in 2019, only certified applicators with a Private, Public, or Commercial license and the Row Crop category will be allowed to PURCHASE or APPLY these products in 2020.** That means authorized purchasers on an applicators license will not be able to buy or apply these products. **No one without a license may apply these products** under supervision of a licensed applicator (which can be done for other products). This training has been approved for 2 Core CEUs.
- To obtain a license, an individual will need to pass **both** the CORE and necessary category exam (Private or Row Crop) with a score of 70% or higher.
 - The Private and Public Applicator licenses - \$100
 - Commercial Licenses - \$250
 - An individual may add the Row Crop category to their existing public or commercial license for no cost by passing the exam with a score of 70% or higher.
 - This 2020 training is required for all applicators using the above product over-the-top in cotton or soybean
