Defoliant and desiccant herbicide for the control of weeds and grasses and as a harvest aid

Active Ingredient:

Paraquat dichloride (1,1'-dimethyl-4,4'- Bipyridinium dichloride)43.8%

Other Ingredients:..... 56.2%

Total:..... 100.0%

Contains 3.0 pounds paraquat cation per gallon as 4.143 pounds Paraquat dichloride salt per gallon.

Contains stench (odor) and emetic.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Applicators and other handlers (except mixers and loaders) must wear:

- Long-sleeved shirt and long pants
- Waterproof gloves, except wear chemical-resistant gloves (Barrier Laminate, Nitrile Rubber ≥ 14 mils, Neoprene Rubber ≥ 14 mils, or Viton[®] ≥ 14 mils) when mixed with oil
- Shoes plus socks
- Protective eyewear
- For other handlers (except mixers and loaders): Wear a minimum of a NIOSH-approved particulate filtering facepiece respirator with any R or P filter; OR a NIOSH-approved elastomeric particulate respirator with any R or P filter; OR a NIOSH-approved powered air purifying respirator with HE filters.
- For applicators: When applying to 80 acres or less in a 24-hour period, if not using an enclosed cab, applicators must wear a minimum of a NIOSH-approved particulate filtering facepiece respirator with any R or P filter; OR a NIOSH-approved elastomeric particulate respirator with any R or P filter; OR a NIOSH-approved powered air purifying respirator with HE filters.
- For applicators: When applying to more than 80 acres in a 24-hour period, applications must be made using an enclosed cab. Enclosed cabs must have a nonporous barrier that totally surrounds occupant and prevents contact with pesticides outside of the cab

Mixers and loaders must wear:

- Long-sleeved shirt and long pants
- Shoes plus socks
- Waterproof gloves, except wear chemical-resistant gloves (Barrier Laminate, Nitrile Rubber ≥ 14 mils, Neoprene Rubber ≥ 14 mils, or Viton[®] ≥ 14 mils) when mixed with oil
- Chemical resistant apron
