2010 County Impacts and Outcomes

Educational Program Focus:

• 4-H Lifeskills

 Agent develops Life Skills in youth through educational delivery methods of clubs, school enrichment, day camps and overnight residential camps.

Impacts

- o 2,864 youth enrolled in the Bay County 4-H Program in 2009
- Youth enrollment in 2009 included 2534 in school enrichment programs, 113 in Day & Residential Camps, and 359 in Club enrollments



- Works with military partners to provide a consistent source of support for military youth. Serves as liaison for German Air Bases.
- o Supervises Northwest OMK Regional Coordinator.



Agent is responsible for recruiting, screening, training, maintaining and recognizing adult and teen volunteers for the Program. Volunteers help leverage county resources by developing community partnerships and collaborations.

Impacts

- o In 2009, there were 13 full time volunteers that lead 4-H clubs, 28 project leaders, and 22 teen volunteers that offered guidance for 4-H projects and activities.
- o These individuals contributed over 6,400 volunteer hours to the 4-H Program.
- o Serves on the Volunteer Focus Team.
