Developing and Supporting 4-H Volunteers

Annual volunteer training topics for volunteers include risk management, creating safe and supportive environments for youth, and creative teaching methods. I also support volunteers with formal and informal training and resources, quality curriculum, lesson plans, and technology to support youth. I am interested in using online methods to reach the Florida 4-H volunteer population. I provide statewide volunteer e-training for the 4-H shooting sports program and the annual Youth Protection training course.

• 4-H Youth Life Skill Development

A variety of program delivery modes are used to reach Washington County 4-H Club members including community-based clubs, project clubs, workshops, day camps, and competitive events. 4-H in the Classroom programs include embryology and public speaking. An average of 1,800 youth per year are reached through Washington County 4-H (45% of the county 5–18-year-old population.
