Program Title: Volunteer and Organizational Systems in Bay County 4-H

This program works with youth and adult volunteers to provide educational programs to the community. I work on building relationships and partnerships with local individuals, businesses or organizations, to increase their knowledge and capacity to advocated for the UF/IFAS Bay County 4-H program.
