Educational Programs

Improving Health and Wellbeing for Adults and Youth in Jefferson County: Obesity and chronic disease contribute to the leading causes of death and disability and contribute significantly to annual health expenditures. Many Floridians do not know how nutrition, unhealthy habits, lifestyle choices, and financial decisions impact their health, wellness, and quality of life. As of 2019, data shows that 70% of Jefferson County residents are at an unhealthy weight. Research shows that unhealthy weight can contribute to heart disease, cancers, complications from COVID-19 and diabetes. In addition, about 84% of adults in Jefferson County are insufficiently active or sedentary (2019, 2020 Florida Charts). It is my job to educate and equip Jefferson County residents with the knowledge to help make positive lifestyle changes that will enhance overall health and quality of life.

Promoting Food Safety and Entrepreneurial Development in

Jefferson County: The Center for Disease Control (CDC) estimates that each year nearly 48 million people get sick from a foodborne illness (CDC.gov). It is my job to ensure youth and adults know the proper food safety and food handling practices to avoid foodborne illness. I teach ServSafe certification courses to help individuals become nationally certified in food safety which helps combat foodborne illnesses.
